Owner's Guide & Parts List for Hudson Trombone® Sprayer

DANGER

Failure to observe **CAUTIONS** and to follow instructions for use and maintenance can cause hose or other parts to become corroded, or weakened.

DO NOT use flammables with this sprayer since it is not designed nor intended for such usage. Use of flammables could result in Serious Injury from unintended ignition or explosion.

Before using any pesticide or other spray materials with this sprayer **READ THE LABEL ON THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINER THOROUGHLY AND FOLLOW ITS DIRECTIONS**. Some spray materials are dangerous and should not be used with this sprayer as they can damage the sprayer and cause serious bodily injury or property damage.

DO NOT use caustics (alkalies) or corrosives (acids) with this sprayer as these can corrode metal parts or weaken hose and gaskets.

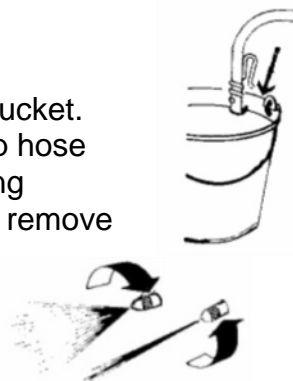
DO NOT use hot or boiling liquids in sprayer as this may weaken hose.

DO wear protective gloves, clothing and goggles.

HOW TO USE:

Mix spray solution in container, such as a bucket. Put strainer end of hose into bucket and clip hose on rim of container. Prime pump by pumping rapidly, put finger over nozzle on outstroke, remove on instroke.

To adjust spray, turn nozzle cap. Adjust nozzle for desired spraying angle.



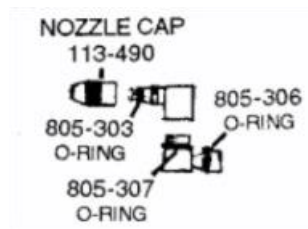
HOW TO MAINTAIN:

Flush with clean water after each use. Occasionally lubricate piston o-ring with petroleum jelly. When reassembling, be sure the U-cup is seated properly (flat face of gasket toward nozzle.)

HOW TO SERVICE:

LEAKS – If liquid leaks around nozzle or cylinder check valve, check o-rings. Clean seating surfaces. Replace o-rings if worn from Kit 6984.

NO SPRAY OR ERRATIC SPRAY – Check for clogs. Also check piston o-ring. Clean surface if worn replace with part from Kit 6984. Lightly lubricate piston o-ring with petroleum jelly.
