

Lesco Chemlawn Spray Gun

This popular gun was developed years ago by Chemlawn. It remains popular today with a reputation of durability and very good drift control.

The gun does require some practice before using, as it is waved back and forth in-front of the operator. This waving motion and walking speed are important for even application.

The droplets are large, so some runoff can be expected.

The gun requires yearly maintenance. Internal assembly kits are readily available. The gun can be rebuilt several times, as corrosion is not a problem.

The blue and yellow nozzles are most common for herbicide applications, the larger nozzles are for liquid fertilizers and fungicides.

The plastic nozzle's life span can be extended by soaking them in mineral oil during the off-season. This prevents the plastic from drying out and cracking.

The trigger assembly should be filled with anti-freeze for off-season storage.

The gun comes with a plastic 3/4" x 1/2" hose barb. After the first season, this barb should be replaced with a brass one, as it becomes weak due to the waving motion.
