

Mounting the Rack to Trailers with Weak Side Rails or Pickup Trucks

If you can not mount directly over an upright support or your trailer rail flexes too much, you can purchase extensions.

Extensions are available in three sizes: 14", 20" or 24".

To determine the length you need, measure from the floor of the trailer to the top of the rail - this is the minimum length that you can use.

This same method can be used to mount to pickup trucks. There are two mounting methods shown: below the rail and inside the rail. The preferred method is below the rail because it leaves the full width of the trailer deck open. Both methods will ensure a rugged mount.
