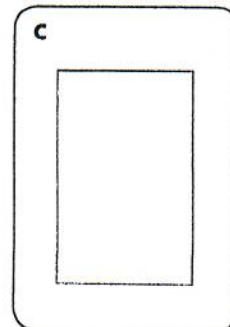
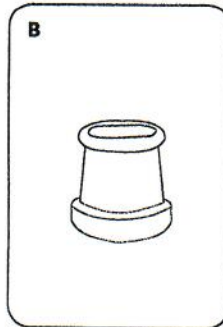
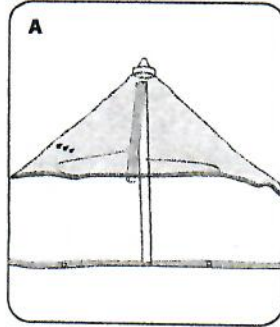


SLF TRAP REPLACEABLE BAG DESIGN

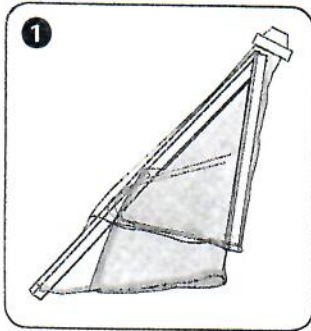
For: Spotted Lanternfly, (*Lycorma delicatula*)

TRAP INCLUDES:

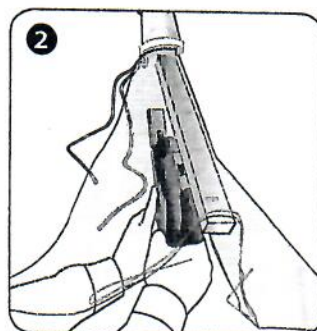
- A. Screen trap body
- B. Trap top cylinder
- C. Replaceable bag
- D. Resealable black cable tie



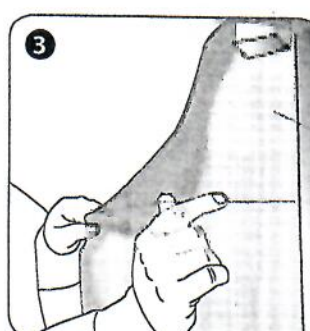
TRAP USE INSTRUCTIONS:



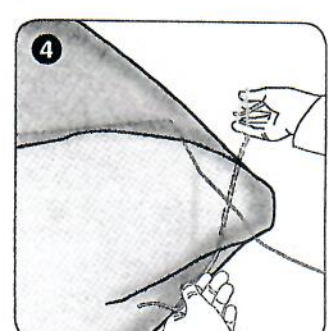
1. Remove screen trap body from box and unfold to resemble picture A.



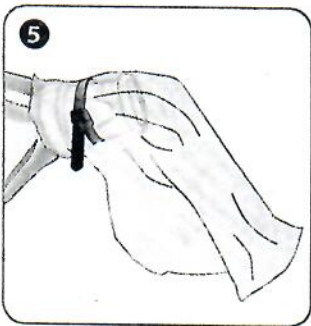
2. Attach trap to tree (about chest level) by drilling drywall screw through the middle point of 18" cedar strip.



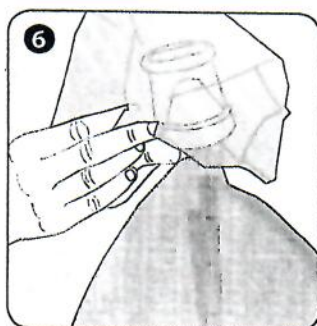
3. Bend the two wires back to help form the shape of the trap.



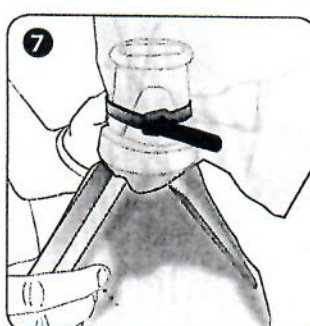
4. Using twine, fishing line, small thin rope, etc. Weave through eyelets at the bottom of trap. Tie twine behind tree.



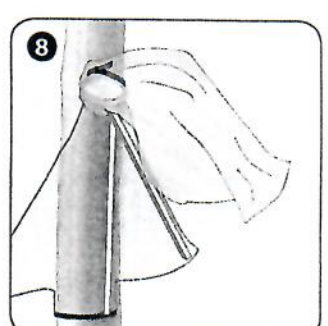
5. **IMPORTANT:** Make sure that when trap is bent over slightly, the tongue sticking out of the cylinder is at the top facing downward. This helps to hold replaceable bag open so that Spotted Lanternflies will fall into the bag.



6. Open replaceable bag and gather bag opening around base of cylinder.



7. Place resealable black cable tie around replaceable bag and cylinder and pull until taut.



8. Check traps a couple of times a week and empty replaceable bag.
